A Resolution to Discourage Trade War with China

WHEREAS, President-elect Donald Trump has postulated increasingly escalating tariffs on the People's Republic of China; and

WHEREAS, said tariffs would likely reignite tensions over previous tariffs and would fuel a trade war between the US and China; and

WHEREAS, the proposed tariffs would likely invite devastating economic reciprocation from China, negatively impacting US trade and foreign relations; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED by the Congress here assembled that the use of executive power by the incoming administration for unilateral tariffs on Chinese goods is heavily discouraged; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that any action taken to implement the proposed tariff plan should be halted immediately to prevent a major escalation of tensions.
